

Getting started with CPR

We are going to use the Calibrated Peer Review system
to learn to write good cognitive ethnography texts and to learn to critically read and evaluate cognitive ethnography texts

What should I do while writing my text?

- Meet these grading criteria on the course web page:
 - Documents: Proj 1 CPR Text Grading Criteria

- I recommend you write your text in a word processor on your own computer
- Save often while writing

What to do after writing your text

- Set up your Calibrated Peer Review account
 - Go to CPR login page (access via a link at the bottom of the course web page or
 - <http://cpr.molsci.ucla.edu/cpr/cpr/login.asp>)
 - Select “New users: first time logging in?”
 - Select your institution “University of California San Diego”
 - Use your student ID to enter the site
 - You will be issued a CPR ID code (write it down)
 - Choose a password (remember it)
 - If you added late, send the professor an email (ehutchins@ucsd.edu). Include your student ID and say that you need an account on CPR.

And then...

- Log in to CPR using your user ID and password
 - Take the CPR tutorial and quiz
 - You MUST complete the tutorial before you can use the system to submit your assignments.

And then ...

- Before January 17 (8:00 PM) submit your text to CPR
 - Format your text using basic html (see Basic HTML formatting on the documents tab)
 - Save your text as .txt
 - Log in to CPR
